for the



Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) and Post Vocational Teacher Education (PVTE) programs on offer during Christmas Vacation Period 2018/2019

RATIONALE/PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The University of Goroka (UOG) through its business arm, Unigor Ltd commenced offering PGDE & PVTE programs last Christmas Vacation Period (CVP). The recent move to have these programs run as projects is in response to the national need for teacher training of 'untrained' & 'unqualified' teachers in the Education system. These programs will continue this year and beyond until the demand for 'qualified professional teachers' in schools is met. Appointment of 'untrained/unqualified' teachers in schools is forced on by increased student numbers and more new schools. UOG has responded to specifically design and offer these programs for 'untrained'/unqualified' teachers. It assures stakeholders that graduates from these programs will be equipped to become effective classroom teachers. The programs are offered in two subsequent Sessions of six weeks each. Courses offered face-to-face in each Session are assessed in the 6th Week. Microteaching & Teaching Practice are conducted during School Term 3.

<u>SESSION 1 PGDE/PVTE PROGRAMS – NEW CANDIDATES FOR 2018/2019 CVP: Course Duration:</u> Session 1 Courses begin 3rd December 2018 & end 11th January 2019. Candidates travel to respective training venues by 30th November 2018.

<u>Venues for Session 1 Courses (New Candidates):</u> Session 1 Courses for the two programs will be offered in five locations: (1) **Mt. Hagen** (Upper Highlands); (2) **Goroka Campus** (Lower Highlands/ MOMASE regions); (3) **Madang** (MOMASE Region); (4) **NCD** (Southern Region); and (5) **Kokopo** (New Guinea Islands Region).

NOTE: Specific locations/sites and charges for accommodation will be communicated through the offer letter.

Candidates travel in by 30th November 2018.

<u>Course Fees Session 2:</u> K6,806 covers TP Supervision costs. Accommodation at the Campus will be organized and separate fees levied to candidates accordingly through the offer letter.

PGDE/PVTE CANDIDATES ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: A candidate for these two programs must have;

- Filled an Application Form,
- A first degree in any discipline from a recognized University for the PGDE program or
- A diploma in any discipline from a recognized college or university for the PVTE program or
- A tradesman certificate in a technical field of specialization for the PVTE program,
- A minimum of 1 year teaching experience in schools or any related training institution,
- Support letters from the Provincial Education Advisors for those currently teaching in schools,
- Two referees supporting for the program for those not teaching in schools,
- Certified copies of transcripts and certificates enclosed,
- A recent passport size photograph duly signed is attached to the Application Form.

VACANCIES FOR TEACHING CONSULTANTS:

Teaching Consultants are required to teach courses offered in the PGDE/PVTE programs in four training venues; Mt. Hagen, Madang, NCD & Kokopo. Engagement Period 8 weeks - begins 26/11/18 and ends 18/1/19 - 1 week preparation, 6 weeks teaching and another week completion of assessment tasks. Those who wish to offer their expertise during these Sessions can express interest for one of the above courses listed in the program structures.

The consultant must;

- Have professional teacher training qualification with minimum of three years teaching experience at tertiary level involving adult learning approaches.
- Have postgraduate qualification in the relevant field of study.
- Have evidence of teaching and learning modules on the subject or course to be offered.
- Have formal release from current employment to engage in this Vacation Period if employed.
- Prepare to work under pressure to meet preparation, teaching and assessment deadlines, and
- Be available for 8 weeks duration at the training venue a week before and a week after the 6-week program.
- Must be able to secure accommodation and transport to the training venue applied for.
- With support references from present or recent past employment.
