ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

A. POSTGRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMS AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

1. Doctor of Philosophy (by Research) – 8 semesters

- **Education**
- **Science**

The University of Goroka (UOG) offers a Doctor of Philosophy in most of the disciplines that are offered at postgraduate level. Prospective students that wish to in pursuing doctoral studies can contact the Director for Graduate Studies or the relevant Dean in a School. For Admission and Program Regulations governing the Doctor of Philosophy are advised to consult or obtain the University of Goroka Post Graduate Studies Handbook and consult the appropriate section of the publication. The degree of Doctor of Philosophy is offered in the School of Education and the School of Science and Technology. A person interested in taking up doctoral studies may consult the relevant School Dean or Director, Post Graduate Studies.

Entry Requirements:

- Degree of Master or a Bachelor with First Class Honors or equivalent from a Senate-recognized institution shall be eligible to apply to register as a student of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy.
- Applications should be made to the Chair of Post Graduate Studies Admissions and should include the details required by the prescribed form for Application for doctoral studies and a research proposal.
- The Application, upon receipt, will be registered and forwarded to the relevant School Post Graduate Studies for a recommendation to the Senate or its delegate. A recommendation for registration to doctoral studies must include the proposed name(s) of one or more supervisors.
- Applicants for the Doctor of Philosophy, upon admission will be registered provisionally for six months. Students, within the six months will be required to develop and prepare their thesis. At the end of that period Senate or its delegate - to confirm or cancel the student's candidature - will review the prepared work.
- A student's candidature will commence, if the review is confirmed, from the commencement of admission.
- All other Regulations regarding the Doctor of Philosophy candidature can be found in the UOG Post Graduate Studies Handbook.

- Applicants without an Honors qualification but wish to apply for a Masters must have an average GPA of 3.0 or better at undergraduate studies in 300- and 400-level of Bachelor of Education courses or equivalent.

- Where necessary, applicants with two years of work experience in a relevant field of education must supply two references from current or recent employer for more than two years. References from employers more than 5 years ago will not be considered.

- Obtained a degree of Bachelor at the University of Goroka with a GPA of at least 2.7 in 300 – and 400 – level courses in the appropriate major.
- Obtained from another tertiary institution a qualification deemed suitable or equivalent to that of the above by the Senate or its delegate.

- Applicants without an Honors qualification but wish to apply for a Masters must have an average GPA of 3.0 or better at undergraduate studies in Years 3 and 4 of Bachelor of Arts courses or equivalent.

- A research proposal of 500 words maximum in a nominated field of study.
- Applicants without an Honors qualification but wish to apply for a Masters must have an average GPA of 3.0 or better at undergraduate studies in Years 3 and 4 of Bachelor of Business courses or equivalent.
- Any other qualification and/or experience deemed appropriate by the Admissions Committee.

- Professional Registration as a Nurse with PNG Nursing Council.
- More than three years of work experiences in the area of maternal health services of the government, church and NGOs.
- Plus satisfactory inspector's or supervisor's reports (Inspection report must be within the last five years from the date of application).
- Any other qualification and experience deemed appropriate by the Admissions Committee.

5. Diploma in PVTE Health – 2 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Certificate or Diploma in Nursing in any health professional specialty from accredited institutions recognized by NDOH.
- Professional Registration as a Nurse with PNG Nursing Council.
- More than three years of work experiences in the area of Health Education or Health Teaching with health services of the government, church and NGOs.
- Plus satisfactory inspector's or supervisor's reports (Inspection report must be within the last five years from the date of application). For Health Teaching, the applicant should be recommended and supported by health training institutions.
- Any other qualification and experience deemed appropriate by the Admissions Committee.

6. Diploma in PVTE Agriculture (In-service) - 2 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma Tropical Agriculture or PCD Agriculture with a minimum GPA of 2.4.
- More than three years of work experiences in the area of Agriculture or Agriculture Extension.
- Plus satisfactory inspector's or supervisor's reports (Inspection report must be within the last five years from the date of application).
- Any other qualification and experience deemed appropriate by the Admissions Committee.

- More than two years of teaching experience.

5 Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management (Transit Program for Applicants with Prior Qualifications) – 4 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma in Tourism and Hospitality Management, Hotel Operations Management or any other related field with high GPAs from recognized institutions with high GPAs
- Relevant diploma qualifications that fit into any of the Bachelor of Arts or Business specializations offered at the university.
- Preferences will be given to UOG graduates.

4. Bachelor of Applied Science (In-service- Secondary- Home Economics) – 4 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma in Teaching Secondary
- Professional registration as a teacher.
- More than two years of teaching experience.
- Satisfactory Report from the Regional Standard Officer of applicant’s performance (Report must be within the last five years from the date of application).
- Any other qualification and experience deemed appropriate by the Admissions Committee.

5. Bachelor of Technical Vocational Education and Training(BTVET) - Business Studies (In-service - Content) –4 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma or higher qualification in business studies from a recognized institution.
- Must have at least 2 years work experience after diploma qualification.
- Produce at least two (2) references (character / professional).
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 obtained from prior diploma qualification attained.
- Those that do not have grade 11 and 12 education must matriculate and have attained minimum of B and C grades first before they apply.
- A successful candidate must satisfy all of the above criteria to qualify for selection.

6. Bachelor of Technical Vocational Education and Training (BTVET) -Technical (In-service) – Content - 4 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma in any engineering field from a recognized institution.
- Completed four (4) years apprenticeship training and acquired NATTB Tradesman Certificate in relevant technical trades.
- Must have at least 2 years work experience after apprenticeship training or engineering diploma.
- Produce at least two (2) references (character / professional).
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 obtained from prior diploma or last qualification attained
- Those that do not have grade 11 and 12 education must matriculate and have attained minimum of B and C grades first before they apply.
- A successful candidate must satisfy either the first and the rest of the criteria or the second and the rest of the criteria to qualify for selection.

7. National Advanced Diploma in Automotive Engineering –In-service – Content - 6 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Current Motor Mechanic tradesman with technical qualifications.
- With four years apprenticeship training and tradesmen certificate
- Current technician with Grade 10 or basic education.
- Possess trade testing certificate Level 1, 2, 3 or NQF 1, 2, 3 & 4 with good practical experience.

8. Diploma in Hotel Operations Management - 4 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Grade 12 GPA with minimum of 2.4 or equivalent to grade 12 certificate with
- C grade in Language and Literature, Science and Mathematics or better.
- Or Grade 10 with National Certificate III & IV in Hospitality
- Or Grade 10 with National Certificate III or IV in Hospitality with minimum 3 years of experience in Hotel industry and
- Minimum STAT P percentile of 50

9. Diploma in Tourism and Hospitality Management – 4 Semesters

Entry Requirements

- Grade 12 with a minimum GPA of 2.4 or equivalent from recognized institutions.
- C grade or better in Language and Literature and Advanced/General Math.
- C grade or better in Science or Humanities courses and experience in Hotel industry
- Minimum STAT P percentile of 50

10. Diploma in Teaching Technical Vocational Education and Training (DTTVET) – Business Studies (In-service) - 2 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma or higher qualification in business studies from a recognized institution.
- Must have at least 5 years work experience after diploma qualification.
- Produce at least two (2) references (character / professional).
- Minimum GPA of 2 obtained from last qualification attained.
- Those that do not have grade 11 and 12 education must matriculate and have attained minimum of B and C grades first before they apply.
- A successful candidate must satisfy all of the above criteria to qualify for selection.

11. Diploma in Teaching Technical Vocational Education and Training (DTTVET) – Technical (In-service) - 2 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma in any engineering field from a recognized institution.
- Completed four (4) years Apprenticeship Training and acquired NATTB Tradesman Certificate in relevant technical trades.

- Must have at least 5 years work experience after Apprenticeship Training or Engineering Diploma.
- Produce at least two (2) references (character / professional).
- Minimum GPA of 2 obtained from last qualification attained.
- Those that do not have grade 11 and 12 education must matriculate and have attained minimum of B and C grades first before they apply.
- A successful candidate must satisfy either the first and the rest of the criteria or the second and the rest of the criteria to qualify for selection.

INSTITUTE OF DISTANCE AND FLEXIBLE LEARNING (IDFL)

1. Bachelor of Education in School Management (Secondary/Primary – In-service) – 4 to 8 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Diploma in Education or related teaching field (secondary, primary, or vocational & technical education).
- Experienced serving or recently serving principal of a school in the PNG school system or similar.
- Experienced senior teacher or aspiring teacher with proven potential to hold leadership roles in schools as recommended by the Regional Standards Officer or Provincial Education Advisor.
- Special considerations will be given to female teachers and teachers from rural and remote schools.

2. Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management – 8 to 12 semesters

Entry Requirements

- Grade 12 with a minimum GPA of 2.4 or equivalent from recognized institutions.
- C or better in Language and Literature, or B in Applied English.
- C in Advanced Mathematics, or B in General Mathematics.
- C grade or better in Science or Humanities subjects in Year 12.
- Other qualifications and/or experiences as deemed acceptable by the University
- Minimum STAT P percentile of 50

3. Diploma in Early Childhood Education – 4 to 8 Semesters

Entry Requirements
